- Please arrive at the high school by **6:00 pm** if you plan on having your professional photo taken by our photographer. (Priority is based on arrival time.) The pictures will be made available online <https://tinyurl.com/GrandMarch2018>.
- All students need to be at the school no later than 6:30 pm in order to participate in the Grand March.
- Student Parking: GHS North parking lot is reserved just for Grand March participants. Please enter through the glass doors by the band room.
- Check-in: Remember, **you must pre-register by April 18** to participate in the Grand March.
- When it's time for the Grand March to begin, you will be directed to line up in the hallway behind the auditorium. Keep track of your introduction card!
- Coronation will be at the conclusion of the Grand March.

## **SPECTATOR INFORMATION**

- Guest/Parent Parking: Please use the south parking lot and main doors at GHS.
- Please arrive and be seated in the GHS auditorium before 7:00 pm. No admission will be charged. The Grand March begins promptly at 7:00 pm.
