Dear Parents,

I wanted to let you know what transportation will look like for the Gilbert District this coming school year. We anticipate having fewer students on our buses as multiple families have agreed to transport their students to school this year. We are very grateful for this type of cooperation from our families. We understand the school bus is the best mode of transportation for families.

Due to COVID-19, there are a few changes to bus expectations:

- Students are to wear face coverings on the bus route.
- Students will have assigned seats
- Siblings have been assigned to the same seats, where possible.
- No eating or drinking on the bus.
- We will not be able to transport friends for playdates, athletic practices, etc

Students that use the elementary as a drop off point to then walk home, will be provided a bus at both the intermediate and middle school. These buses will drop these non-route riders off at the elementary school, they can then walk home.
