Who can get free meals?

Any student, whether they are doing in-person learning at school or virtual/remote learning at home, can get free meals.

Where are the free meals available?

Meals are available at each school building for breakfast and lunch, Monday through Friday. Pick up is located at the High School building. Children do not have to be present for meal pick-up. Please go [here](#) for more information and to place orders.

What is being served?

Why have things kept changing?
